How To Diagnose:



Lesions appear chiefly around the peri-orbital areas, nares, digits and conjunctiva.



In severe cases, secondary bacterial infection causes rupture of the vesicle and pus formation.



Usually, squabs are affected during nestling stage.



Birds are unable to eat and drink and in severe cases, mortalities are also recorded.

What will you do:

- Isolate the affected ones from the healthy animals.
- Regular screening of the herd for Brucellosis
- Inform nearest Veterinary Doctor/Field Assistant.
- Send appropriate samples through Veterinary Doctor/Field Assistant to the nearest diagnostic laboratory/ ADMaC Core Lab-I, Khanapara for confirmation of the disease.
- Dispose the aborted materials properly and clean the floor with disinfectants (potash solution, bleaching powder etc).
- Maintain the personal hygiene and keep farm surrounding clean.
